



HOW TO UPGRADE TO FOREVER HISTORIAN SOFTWARE

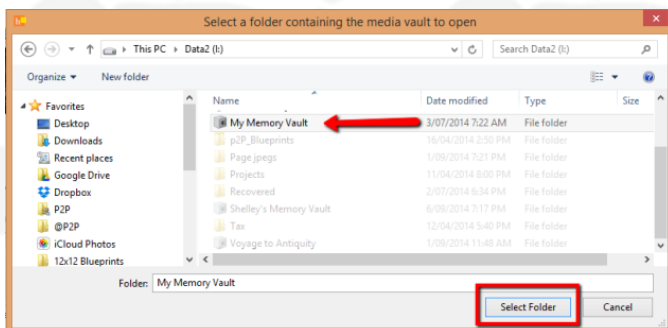
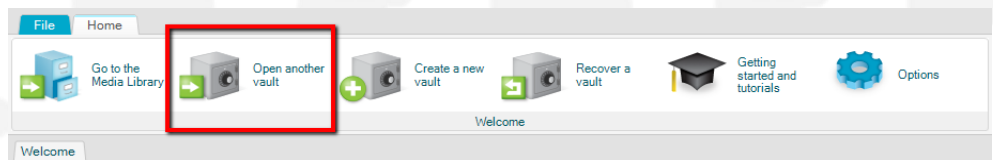
This information is for users of Memory Manager branded software who wish to start using Forever's Historian program instead. Memory Manager is longer being supported or updated, and cannot be activated if it is necessary to move it to a new computer. We recommend that you make the switch to Historian as soon as it is feasible for you.

INSTALL HISTORIAN

If you do not own Historian, you can purchase it from Forever.com. After purchasing Historian, download it and follow the simple on-screen instructions. When you open Historian you'll see that it looks very similar to Memory Manager 4, so you will be very comfortable and be able to find your way around easily.

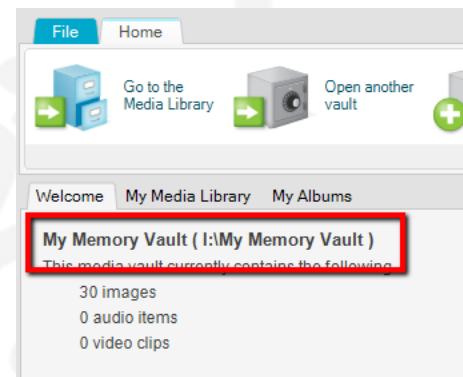
OPEN A MEMORY VAULT

To open an existing Memory Manager Memory vault, click "Open another vault" from the Home Ribbon on the Welcome page.



Browse to the location of your existing Memory Manager 4 Vault. Click once to select the vault and click "Select Folder" (do not open the folder). Your Memory vault will open and will look the same as it did in Memory Manager 4. All your sorting – categories, tags, star ratings, 'Tell the Story', etc. – will be intact.

To find out where your existing memory vault is, open Memory Manager 4. On the welcome screen, the file location of your memory vault will be visible at the top left of the screen, just under the tabs.



NOTES

Historian will open Memory vaults from MM2 or MM3; you do not need to upgrade to MM4 first. However, you will notice a number of improvements and changes in Historian compared to MM2 or MM3.

Since Historian and MM4 are so similar, most of the training in MM4 on pixels2pages.net also applies to Historian.
