

# Mystery Page No. 08

#P2PMYSTERYPAGE008

For this Mystery Page, photos take in sequence work really well.



1. Choose 9 photos. 8 will be square and 1 will be a larger landscape photograph.
2. Add an empty photo frame. Insert > Empty frame. Size it to 5 x 3.6.
3. Add a frame to the photo frame. Click on photo frame > Photo > Select > Built In Kits > Frames > Black Tabs.
4. Add photo to frame. Drag and drop in your landscape photograph.
5. Download the zipped folder containing the filmstrip .png (*see link in post*). Extract the folder. In Artisan, go to the Photos tab and import the .png as a photo. Add filmstrip .png element to your page.
6. Insert 4 empty photo frames. Size to fit the film strip and place them behind the filmstrip edges.
7. Group filmstrip and photos together. Click on each one while holding down the Shift Key. Choose Grouping > Group.
8. Copy and paste filmstrip png and photos to create one more set. Now you can tilt and arrange each set on the page to suit. Once they are in position, ungroup.
9. Add in photos. Drag and drop photos into the 8 empty photo frames.
10. Add in background paper. Choose one that has a subtle and textured look.
10. Add in text box. Edit the text box shape by right clicking on the text box > Shape > edit shape. Position the text box between the 2 film strips.
12. Fill in text box with journaling. Pick a font that enhances your photographs.
13. Add in embellishments. Pick a few that reflect your photos.
14. Add shadows. Use light or heavy shadows to the 2 filmstrips as needed. Add shadows to the embellishments and the one large photo frame.
15. Add in a title to complete your page.
